

LANGSTONE HARBOUR LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 01 OF 2025

Diving Operations on Langstone Harbour Ferry Pontoon

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that diving operations will take place on the Hayling Ferry pontoon intermittently from Thursday 6th February until 10th March 2025 or this notice is cancelled.

The work will be coordinated with the Hayling Ferry so that there is no disruption to scheduled services.

To ensure the safety of divers at all times, the **Master of any other vessel wishing to use the pontoon during this period, including the fuel berth should contact the harbour office in advance**.



Diving operations will take place during the day between 0900 and 1700 and will be indicated by **Code Flag Alpha** when divers are in the water.

Vessels are requested to reduce their wash in the vicinity of pontoons for the duration of these works - **Code Flags Romeo Yankee**.

If required, a harbour patrol vessel may also be alongside the pontoons and may be contacted for further information on VHF Ch 68.
